## Minutes of C.K.A. Committee Meeting

## of September 18th 1995

- 1. The minutes of the last meeting were approved.
- 2. Paul Bullough from Phoenix is now the 2nd Division League Officer.
- 3. Matters arising: City Sport Course - This will be going to Kites as City had the last one. Dave Rogers is the contact.

Development Officer - This post is still vacant and desperately needs filling.

4. Equipment - Hughie made the point that the equipment at Impington must be returned by 29th September.

3 sets of equipment have been borrowed from Norwich. The 2 full size posts will stored at Kelsey Kerridge.

There has been a great deal of confusion over missing balls....Originally all clubs had 2 balls from the C.K.A. Every club needs to write down a list of assets to avoid any further confusion.

Thea has organised the shipping of equipment from Holland. This will cost £250 and be divided by the number of posts being brought over.

She will keep them until they are collected.

2 extra balls will be bought for Impington from Holland financed by C.K.A.

5. Refereeing Issues - 20 people attended the refereeing course, thanks go especially to Thea and Hughie. It was thought that initially a good way in for new refs. would be at club training practices. There were a number of Kites who have shown an interest in going on a course, so perhaps another one may be arranged during the University term.

A discusion followed on devising a fair refereeing policy, incorporating all the clubs, but also acknowledging that some clubs

would have many more experienced players than others. Unfortunately the matter was not resolved and will be brought up at the next meeting.

6. B.K.A. affiliation - Clubs that paid £5 for temp. membership this year need only pay an extra £5. It was agreed that only the teams in the top league would affiliate. In the first year it would cost £10 per club and £40 per team and in the second year it would go up to £80 per team. Robert made the point that the cost may put teams off being promoted. It was felt though that if clubs knew the cost in advance it would be O.K.

- 7. Youth Development Scott has been hard at work organising a training day for primary school children which is taking place at Impington on Sat.23rd Sept.

  If anyone is free to help it would be greatly appreciated. We still need more contacts with secondary school teachers.
- 8. News from Holland The recent trip to Holland was a great success. Many thanks to Hughie for all the organisation. "It was a bit of a result!"

  A couple of the clubs may come over to us next year.

Max Buttinger has got 2 teams coming over from Friesland, that may arrive on 24th October. The possibility of booking a University slot at K.K is being looked into and on the Wednesday it may be possible to have a slot at either Impington or C.R.C.

- 9. The League will be starting on Monday 9th October.
- 10. As a result of the County Squad's training and championships, a profit of £20 was made subject to the sale of 5 county squad t-shirts to the C.K.A.
